If the requested data for a particular block is not applicable, enter a dash (-). Also, if you don't know the exact answer for a particular block, please give your best estimate. In order for an associate member to receive the Builder Magazine they must be classified with an occupation code ranging from (A-Z). A "Z" or "other" classification code must also be further defined by writing the members specific occupation in the space provided. Any associate member not classified as outlined will not receive a copy of the Builder Magazine.
